Job Description

LJP is locally owned, growing company looking for safe, responsible drivers who want to be home daily. Full time benefits include medical and life insurance, paid time off, uniforms and a retirement plan with company match.

Job Purpose:

Drivers are responsible for performing assigned duties on container delivery and hauling. Roll off drivers transport containers and compactors from customers to our receiving area or disposal sites, operating safely on roadways and following all CDL laws.

Typical Duties:

- Physically strenuous position which requires mounting and dismounting a heavy-duty truck numerous times a day and regularly involves lifting (up to 50 - 75 pounds), pushing, pulling, and bending.
- Backing skills are essential. Routes require drivers to navigate through congested communities and confined and/or tight areas in city and suburban locations.
- Perform required "user maintenance" and complete required reports.
- Drivers are expected to communicate professionally with customers and dispatch at all times, and comply with all local, state, and federal transportation regulations and with Company policies.

Skills/Qualifications:

- High School Diploma/GED. Must be able to pass criminal background checks and drug testing.
- Class B license required.
- Must be legally eligible to work in the United States and be at least 21 years of age.
- Must be able to speak and read English at a level consistent with general conversation with the public and response to official questions and be able to understand and obey highway traffic signals.
- Must have legible handwriting to complete paperwork for billing and prepare pre and post trip truck inspections.
- Must be able to find rural area locations from maps.
- Must be able to tolerate working in extreme hot/cold, wet/dry weather conditions.
